premises may not sell and must dispose of the property or donate it to a charitable institution that is exempt from federal income tax under s. 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code for sale or other disposition as that charitable institution deems appropriate. The rightful owner of the property may reclaim the property from the owner or operator of the premises at any time before the disposition or donation of the property in accordance with this section and the established policies and procedures of the owner or operator of the premises. A charitable institution that accepts any electronic device, as defined in s. 815.03(9), access to which is not secured by a password or other personal identification technology, must make reasonable efforts to delete the personal data from the electronic device prior to its sale or other disposition, unless the institution chooses to discard it or donate it to another charitable institution.
