Between lines 225 and 226, insert:

Section 7. Subsection (1) of section 1001.26, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

1001.26 Public broadcasting program system.—

(1) There is created a public broadcasting program system for the state. The department shall provide funds, as specifically appropriated in the General Appropriations Act, to educational television stations qualified by the Corporation for Public Broadcasting or public colleges and universities that are

14 system must include:

15 (a) Support for existing Corporation for Public
16 Broadcasting qualified program system educational television
17 stations.

18 (b) Maintenance of quality broadcast capability for
19 educational stations that are part of the program system.

20 (c) Interconnection of all educational stations that are
21 part of the program system for simultaneous broadcast and of
22 such stations with all universities and other institutions as
23 necessary for sharing of resources and delivery of programming.

24 (d) Establishment and maintenance of a capability for
25 statewide program distribution with facilities and staff,
26 provided such facilities and staff complement and strengthen
27 existing educational television stations.

28 (e) Provision of both statewide programming funds and
29 station programming support for educational television to meet
30 statewide priorities. Priorities for station programming need
31 not be the same as priorities for programming to be used
32 statewide. Station programming may include, but shall not be
33 limited to, citizens' participation programs, music and fine
34 arts programs, coverage of public hearings and governmental
35 meetings, equal air time for political candidates, and other
36 public interest programming.

37 Section 8. Subsection (4) of section 1011.90, Florida
38 Statutes, is amended to read:

39 1011.90 State university funding.—

40 (4) The Board of Governors shall establish and validate a
41 cost-estimating system consistent with the requirements of
42 subsection (1) and shall report as part of its legislative
43 budget request the actual expenditures for the fiscal year
44 ending the previous June 30. The legislative budget request must
45 also include 5-year trend information on the number of faculty
46 and administrators at each state university. The Board of
47 Governors shall define the faculty and administrative personnel
48 classifications and include the definitions in the legislative
49 budget request. Expenditure analysis, operating budgets, and
50 annual financial statements of each university must be prepared
51 using the standard financial reporting procedures and formats
52 prescribed by the Board of Governors. These formats shall be the
53 same as used for the 2000-2001 fiscal year reports. Any
54 revisions to these financial and reporting procedures and
55 formats must be approved by the Executive Office of the Governor
56 and the appropriations committees of the Legislature jointly
57 under the provisions of s. 216.023(3). The Board of Governors
58 shall continue to collect and maintain at a minimum management
59 information existing on June 30, 2002. The expenditure analysis
60 report shall include total expenditures from all sources for the

63 Section 9. Subsection (24) is added to section 1013.30 to
64 read:

65 (24) A local governmental entity may not prevent public
66 motor vehicle use or access to an existing transportation
67 facility or transportation corridor, as those terms are defined
68 in s. 334.03, if the transportation facility or transportation
69 corridor is one of only two or fewer ingress and egress points
70 into a state university as defined in s. 1000.21 and regulated
71 by the Board of Governors of the State University System as
72 provided in s. 20.155.
