

House Joint Resolution

A joint resolution proposing amendments to Section 8 of Article I and Section 5 of Article VIII of the State Constitution to remove certain restrictions on the purchase of personal firearms by active duty servicemembers.

Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

That the following amendments to Section 8 of Article I and Section 5 of Article VIII of the State Constitution are agreed to and shall be submitted to the electors of this state for approval or rejection at the next general election or at an earlier special election specifically authorized by law for that purpose:

ARTICLE I

DECLARATION OF RIGHTS

SECTION 8. Right to bear arms.—

(a) The right of the people to keep and bear arms in defense of themselves and of the lawful authority of the state shall not be infringed, except that the manner of bearing arms may be regulated by law.

(b) There shall be a mandatory period of three days, excluding weekends and legal holidays, between the purchase and delivery at retail of any handgun. For the purposes of this

26 | section, "purchase" means the transfer of money or other  
 27 | valuable consideration to the retailer, and "handgun" means a  
 28 | firearm capable of being carried and used by one hand, such as a  
 29 | pistol or revolver. A person who is a holder ~~holders~~ of a  
 30 | concealed weapon permit or who is an active duty servicemember  
 31 | as prescribed by general ~~in Florida~~ law is ~~shall~~ not be subject  
 32 | to this restriction ~~the provisions of this paragraph~~.

33 | (c) ~~The legislature shall enact~~ Legislation implementing  
 34 | subsection (b) must ~~of this section, effective no later than~~  
 35 | ~~December 31, 1991, which shall provide that~~ a person who  
 36 | violates anyone violating the provisions of subsection (b)  
 37 | commits ~~shall be guilty of~~ a felony.

42 | SECTION 5. Local option.—

43 | (a) Local option on the legality or prohibition of the  
 44 | sale of intoxicating liquors, wines or beers shall be preserved  
 45 | to each county. The status of a county with respect thereto  
 46 | shall be changed only by vote of the electors in a special  
 47 | election called upon the petition of twenty-five per cent of the  
 48 | electors of the county, and not sooner than two years after an  
 49 | earlier election on the same question. Where legal, the sale of  
 50 | intoxicating liquors, wines and beers shall be regulated by law.

51 (b) Each county may ~~shall have the authority to~~ require a  
 52 criminal history records check and a 3 to 5-day waiting period,  
 53 excluding weekends and legal holidays, in connection with the  
 54 sale of any firearm occurring within such county. For purposes  
 55 of this subsection, the term "sale" means the transfer of money  
 56 or other valuable consideration for any firearm when any part of  
 57 the transaction is conducted on property to which the public has  
 58 the right of access. Holders of a concealed weapons permit as  
 59 prescribed by general law shall not be subject to the provisions  
 60 of this subsection when purchasing a firearm. A person who is an  
 61 active duty servicemember as prescribed by general law shall not  
 62 be subject to a waiting period authorized by this subsection.

69 PURCHASE OF PERSONAL FIREARMS BY ACTIVE DUTY  
 70 SERVICEMEMBERS.—The Florida Constitution provides for waiting  
 71 periods under state law and county ordinances in connection with  
 72 certain sales of firearms. The waiting periods do not apply to  
 73 holders of a concealed weapon permit, but the waiting periods do  
 74 apply to active duty servicemembers. The amendment exempts  
 75 active duty servicemembers from such waiting periods.
