14	(1) Property to the value of $\frac{55,000}{500}$ of every widow,
15	widower, blind person, or totally and permanently disabled
16	person who is a bona fide resident of this state is exempt from
17	taxation. As used in this section, the term "totally and
18	permanently disabled person" means a person who is currently
19	certified by a physician licensed in this state, by the United
20	States Department of Veterans Affairs or its predecessor, or by
21	the Social Security Administration to be totally and permanently
22	disabled.
23	Section 2. The amendment made by this act to s. 196.202(1),
24	Florida Statutes, applies to tax years beginning on or after
25	January 1, 2019.
