21	one person which exceeds the sum of <u>\$300,000</u> \$200,000 or any

32	limited waiver of sovereign immunity provided herein, the state
33	or an agency or subdivision thereof may agree, within the limits
34	of insurance coverage provided, to settle a claim made or a
35	judgment rendered against it without further action by the
36	Legislature, but the state or agency or subdivision thereof
37	shall not be deemed to have waived any defense of sovereign
38	immunity or to have increased the limits of its liability as a
39	result of its obtaining insurance coverage for tortious acts in
40	excess of the <u>\$300,000</u> \$200,000 or <u>\$500,000</u> \$300,000 waiver
