7 Section 1. Subsection (4) of section 465.019, Florida
 8 Statutes, is amended to read:

9 465.019 Institutional pharmacies; permits.-

10 (4) Medicinal drugs shall be dispensed in an institutional
 11 pharmacy to outpatients only when that institution has secured a
 12 community pharmacy permit from the department. However, ~~an~~
 13 ~~individual licensed to prescribe medicinal drugs in this state~~
 14 ~~may be dispensed by dispense up to a 24-hour supply of a~~
 15 ~~medicinal drug to any patient of an emergency department of a~~
