Each district must allocate at least 80 36 percent of the funds provided to the district for advanced 37 placement instruction, in accordance with this paragraph, to the 38 high school that generates the funds. The school district shall 39 distribute to each classroom teacher who provided advanced 40 placement instruction: 1. A bonus in the amount of \$50 for each student taught by 41 42 the Advanced Placement teacher in each advanced placement course who receives a score of 3 or higher on the College Board 43 Advanced Placement Examination. 44 45 2. An additional bonus of \$500 to each Advanced Placement 46 teacher in a school designated with a grade of "D" or "F" who 47 has at least one student scoring 3 or higher on the College Board Advanced Placement Examination, regardless of the number 48 49 of classes taught or of the number of students scoring a 3 or 50 higher on the College Board Advanced Placement Examination. 51 52 Bonuses awarded under this paragraph shall be in addition to any 53 regular wage or other bonus the teacher received or is scheduled to receive. For such courses, the teacher shall earn an 54 additional bonus of \$50 for each student who has a qualifying 55 56 score. 57 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2019.

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
