- 4. One member from the Department of Environmental Protection who has expertise in red tide, appointed by the Secretary of Environmental Protection.
- 5. One member from the Fish and Wildlife Research

  Institute who has expertise in red tide, appointed by the

  executive director of the Fish and Wildlife Research Institute.
- 6. One member from the Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services who has expertise in water quality, appointed by the Commissioner of Agriculture and Consumer Services.
- (b) Council members shall serve staggered 2-year terms and may be reappointed.
- (c) Council members shall serve without compensation, and each organization represented shall cover all expenses of its respective representative.
  - (d) The council shall meet at least twice annually.

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
