560.304 Exemption from licensure.—The requirement for licensure under this part does not apply to a person cashing payment instruments when:

(1) The payment instruments that have an aggregate face value of less than  $\frac{$7,500}{$2,000}$  per person per day and that are incidental to the retail sale of goods or services; and

(2) The person's whose compensation for cashing payment instruments at each <u>location</u> site does not exceed 5 percent of the total gross income from the retail sale of goods or services by such person during the last 60 days.
