 2 An act relating to specialty license plates; amending
 3 s. 320.08058, F.S.; directing the Department of
 4 Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles to develop certain
 5 specialty license plates; providing for distribution
 6 and use of fees collected from the sale of the plates;
 7 providing a contingent effective date.

 9 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

 11 Section 1. Subsections (84) and (85) are added to section
 12 320.08058, Florida Statutes, to read:

13 320.08058 Specialty license plates.—

14 (84) KAPPA ALPHA PSI FRATERNITY LICENSE PLATES.—

15 (a) The department shall develop a Kappa Alpha Psi
 16 Fraternity license plate as provided in this section and s.
 17 320.08053. The plate must bear the colors and design approved by
 18 the department. The word "Florida" must appear at the top of the
 19 plate, and the words "Kappa Alpha Psi" must appear at the bottom
 20 of the plate.

21 (b) The annual use fees from the sale of the plate shall
 22 be distributed to the Southern Province of Kappa Alpha Psi
 23 Foundation, Inc., to be used as follows:

24 1. Five percent shall be used solely for marketing of the
 25 Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity license plate.

26 2. Ninety-five percent shall be used for college
 27 scholarships for Florida residents attending historically black
 28 colleges and universities in the state.

29 (85) ALPHA KAPPA ALPHA SORORITY LICENSE PLATES.—

30 (a) The department shall develop an Alpha Kappa Alpha
 31 Sorority license plate as provided in this section and s.
 32 320.08053. The plate must bear the colors and design approved by
 33 the department. The word "Florida" must appear at the top of the
 34 plate, and the words "Alpha Kappa Alpha" must appear at the
 35 bottom of the plate.

36 (b) The annual use fees from the sale of the plate shall
 37 be distributed to the Alpha Kappa Alpha Educational Advancement
 38 Foundation, Inc., to be used as follows:

39 1. Five percent shall be used solely for marketing of the
 40 Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority license plate.

41 2. Ninety-five percent shall be used for college
 42 scholarships for Florida residents attending historically black
 43 colleges and universities in the state.

44 Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2019, but
 45 only if HB 1227 or similar legislation takes effect, if such
 46 legislation is adopted in the same legislative session or an
 47 extension thereof and becomes a law.
