## A bill to be entitled

An act relating to specialty license plates; amending s. 320.08058, F.S.; directing the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles to develop certain specialty license plates; providing for distribution and use of fees collected from the sale of the plates; providing a contingent effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsections (84) and (85) are added to section 320.08058, Florida Statutes, to read:
320.08058 Specialty license plates.-
(84) KAPPA ALPHA PSI FRATERNITY LICENSE PLATES.-
(a) The department shall develop a Kappa Alpha Psi

Fraternity license plate as provided in this section and s. 320.08053. The plate must bear the colors and design approved by the department. The word "Florida" must appear at the top of the plate, and the words "Kappa Alpha Psi" must appear at the bottom of the plate.
(b) The annual use fees from the sale of the plate shall be distributed to the Southern Province of Kappa Alpha Psi Foundation, Inc., to be used as follows:

1. Five percent shall be used solely for marketing of the Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity license plate.

2. Ninety-five percent shall be used for college scholarships for Florida residents attending historically black colleges and universities in the state.
(85) ALPHA KAPPA ALPHA SORORITY LICENSE PLATES.-
(a) The department shall develop an Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority license plate as provided in this section and s. 320.08053. The plate must bear the colors and design approved by the department. The word "Florida" must appear at the top of the plate, and the words "Alpha Kappa Alpha" must appear at the bottom of the plate.
(b) The annual use fees from the sale of the plate shall be distributed to the Alpha Kappa Alpha Educational Advancement Foundation, Inc., to be used as follows:

1. Five percent shall be used solely for marketing of the Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority license plate.
2. Ninety-five percent shall be used for college scholarships for Florida residents attending historically black colleges and universities in the state.

Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2019, but only if HB 1227 or similar legislation takes effect, if such legislation is adopted in the same legislative session or an extension thereof and becomes a law.
