Florida Statutes, is redesignated as subsection (13), a new subsection (12) is added to that section, and subsection (11) of that section is amended, to read:

1007.25 General education courses; common prerequisites; other degree requirements.-

- (11) Students at state universities may request associate in arts degrees <del>certificates</del> if they have successfully completed the minimum requirements for the degree of associate in arts (A.A.). The university must grant the student an associate in arts degree if the student has successfully completed minimum requirements for college-level communication and computation skills adopted by the State Board of Education and 60 academic semester hours or the equivalent within a degree program area, including 36 semester hours in general education courses in the subject areas of communication, mathematics, social sciences, humanities, and natural sciences, consistent with the general education requirements of this section and those specified in the articulation agreement pursuant to s. 1007.23. Each student enrolled in a university must be awarded an A.A. degree as follows:
- (a) If the student completed at least 25 percent of the required semester hours toward the A.A. degree at a Florida College System institution, the university must notify the Florida College System institution of the student's eligibility. The institution shall verify eligibility, accept the credits required for the A.A. degree, and award the degree.
- (b) If the student did not complete at least 25 percent of the required semester hours for the A.A. degree at a Florida College System institution but completed at least 25 percent of

the semester hours toward the A.A. degree at the state university, the state university must award the degree. (12) If a student was previously enrolled in a state university and has successfully completed the minimum requirements for the A.A. degree as determined by the state university, upon the student's failure to enroll before his or her graduation in a fall or spring semester, the student must be awarded an A.A. degree, unless the student declines to receive the degree. Each state university student who qualifies under this subsection must be awarded an A.A. degree as follows: (a) If the student completed at least 25 percent of the required semester hours toward the A.A. degree at a Florida College System institution, the university must notify that Florida College System institution of the student's eligibility. The institution must verify eligibility, accept the credits required for the A.A. degree, and award the degree.
