7	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

9	Section 1. Section 1003.481, Florida Statutes, is amended					
10	to read:					
11	1003.481 Early Childhood Music Education Incentive Pilot					
12	Program					
13	(1) Beginning with the 2017-2018 school year, The Early					
14	Childhood Music Education Incentive Pilot Program is created					
15	within the Department of Education for a period of 3 school					
16	years . The purpose of the pilot program is to assist selected					
17	school districts in implementing comprehensive music education					
18	programs for students in kindergarten through grade 2.					
19	(2) In order for A school district <u>is</u> to be eligible for					
20	participation in the pilot program $\mathrm{if}_{m{ au}}$ the superintendent					
21	<u>certifies</u> must certify to the Commissioner of Education, in a					
22	format prescribed by the department, that each elementary school					
23	within the district has established a comprehensive music					
24	education program that:					
25	(a) Includes all students at the school enrolled in					
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26 kindergarten through grade 2.

(b) Is staffed by certified music educators.

(c) Provides music instruction for at least 30 consecutiveminutes 2 days a week.

30 (d) Complies with class size requirements under s.31 1003.03.

32 (e) Complies with the department's standards for early 33 childhood music education programs for students in kindergarten 34 through grade 2.

35 (3) (a) The commissioner shall select school districts for participation in the pilot program, subject to legislative 36 37 appropriation, based on the school district's proximity to the 38 University of Florida and needs-based criteria established by 39 the State Board of Education. Selected school districts shall annually receive \$150 per full-time equivalent student in 40 41 kindergarten through grade 2 who is enrolled in a comprehensive 42 music education program.

43 To maintain eligibility for participation in the pilot (b) 44 program, a selected school district must annually certify to the 45 commissioner, in a format prescribed by the department, that 46 each elementary school within the district provides a comprehensive music education program that meets the 47 requirements of subsection (2). If a selected school district 48 fails to provide the annual certification for a fiscal year, the 49 50 school district must return all funds received through the pilot

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51	program	for	that	fiscal	year.
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52 (4) The University of Florida's College of Education shall 53 evaluate the effectiveness of the pilot program by measuring 54 student academic performance and the success of the program. The 55 evaluation must include, but is not limited to, a quantitative 56 analysis of student achievement and a qualitative evaluation of 57 students enrolled in the comprehensive music education programs.

58 (5) The State Board of Education may adopt rules to59 administer this section.

60 61 (6) This section expires June 30, 2022 2020.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2019.

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
