



26        (b) The director of the Division of Historical Resources  
 27 of the Department of State.

28        (c) A women's history scholar from a postsecondary  
 29 educational institution in this state, appointed by the  
 30 Governor.

31        (d) A member of the Florida Historical Commission,  
 32 appointed by the Governor.

33        (e) Two members of the Florida Commission on the Status of  
 34 Women, appointed by the Governor.

35        (f) A historian, appointed by the Governor.

36        (g) Two citizen members, appointed by the Governor.

37        (h) A representative recommended by the National Council  
 38 of Negro Women, appointed by the Governor.

39        (3) Appointed members of the committee shall serve at the  
 40 pleasure of the appointing authority and any vacancies shall be  
 41 filled in the same manner as the initial appointment. Members of  
 42 the committee shall designate a chair and a vice chair from  
 43 among its membership. The committee may meet as often as it  
 44 deems necessary to fulfill the duties prescribed in this  
 45 section.

46        (4) In ensuring a suitable statewide observance of the  
 47 centennial of the passage and ratification of the Nineteenth  
 48 Amendment to the United States Constitution, the committee has  
 49 the following duties:

50        (a) Advise on the development of programs and activities

51 appropriate to commemorate the centennial of women's suffrage,  
52 and encourage the development of such programs and activities to  
53 ensure that the commemoration results in a positive legacy and  
54 has long-term benefits.

55 (b) Facilitate the observance of women's suffrage-related  
56 activities throughout the state.

57 (c) Encourage civic, historical, educational, economic,  
58 and other organizations throughout the state to organize and  
59 participate in activities to expand the understanding and  
60 appreciation of women's suffrage.

61 (d) Coordinate and facilitate the public distribution of  
62 scholarly research, publication, and interpretation of women's  
63 suffrage.

64 (e) Encourage local organizations and nonprofit  
65 organizations to further the commemoration of the centennial of  
66 women's suffrage.

67 (5) The Division of Historical Resources of the Department  
68 of State shall provide administrative and staff support for the  
69 committee.

70 (6) This section expires December 31, 2020.

71 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2019.
