An act relating to false personation; amending s. 843.08, F.S.; adding school guardians to the list of officials the false personation of whom is prohibited and is subject to criminal penalties; making technical changes; reenacting s. 921.0022(3)(b), F.S., relating to the offense severity ranking chart of the Criminal Punishment Code, to incorporate the amendment made to s. 843.08, F.S., in a reference thereto; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 843.08, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

843.08 False personation.—A person who falsely assumes or pretends to be a firefighter, <u>a</u> sheriff, <u>an</u> officer of the Florida Highway Patrol, <u>an</u> officer of the Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission, <u>a</u> fire or arson investigator of the Department of Financial Services, <u>an</u> officer of the Department of Financial Services, <u>an</u> officer of the Department of Corrections, <u>a</u> correctional probation officer, <u>a</u> deputy sheriff, <u>a</u> state attorney or <u>an</u> assistant state attorney, <u>a</u> statewide prosecutor or <u>an</u> assistant statewide prosecutor, <u>a</u> state attorney investigator, <u>a</u> coroner, <u>a</u> police officer, <u>a</u> lottery special agent or lottery investigator, <u>a</u> beverage enforcement agent, <u>a</u> school guardian as described in s. 30.15(1)(k), <u>a</u> security officer licensed under chapter 493 or watchman, or any member of the Florida Commission on Offender Review <u>or</u> and

However, a person who falsely personates any such officer during the course of the 38 39 commission of a felony commits a felony of the second degree, 40 punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084. If the commission of the felony results in the death or personal 41 42 injury of another human being, the person commits a felony of the first degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 43 44 775.083, or s. 775.084.
