9 States mail, by hand delivery, by electronic submission, or through a
10 third-party vendor that collects the reports on behalf of the local

12 (b) The State Fire Marshal shall adopt rules to implement a
13 uniform summary inspection report and submission procedures to be used
14 by all third-party vendors and local authorities having jurisdiction.
15 For purposes of this section, a uniform summary inspection report must
16 record the address where the fire protection system or hydrant is

17 located, the company and person conducting the inspection and their
18 license number, the date of the inspection, and the fire protection
19 system or hydrant inspection status, including a brief summary of each
20 deficiency, critical deficiency, noncritical deficiency, or impairment
21 found. A contractor's detailed inspection report is not required to
22 follow the uniform summary inspection report format. The State Fire
23 Marshal shall establish by rule a submission procedure for each means
24 provided under paragraph (a) by which a local authority having
25 jurisdiction may accept uniform summary inspection reports. Each of
26 the submission procedures must allow a contractor to attach additional
27 documents with the submission of a uniform summary inspection report,
28 including a physical copy of the contractor's detailed inspection
29 report. A submission procedure may not require a contractor to submit
30 information contained within the detailed inspection report unless the
31 information is required to be included in the uniform summary
32 inspection report.
