 2           An act relating to Melbourne-Tillman Water Control  
 3           District, Brevard County; amending ch. 2001-336, Laws  
 4           of Florida; providing public hearing notice  
 5           requirements for the 2019-2020 budget year; revising  
 6           voting requirements relating to the stormwater  
 7           management user fee; providing an effective date.

 9   Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

 11           Section 1. Paragraph (c) of subsection (12) of section 8  
 12           of section 3 of chapter 2001-336, Laws of Florida, is amended to  
 13           read:

14           Section 8. Powers given the Board to effect a surface  
 15           water management system within District boundaries.—In order to  
 16           responsibly, efficiently, and effectively secure, operate, and  
 17           maintain an adequate, dependable surface water management  
 18           system, the Board of Directors, consistent with and supportive  
 19           of the state water policy, the state water use plan, the state  
 20           land development plan, and the regional policy plan, shall:

22           (c) Notice of such public hearing for the 2019-2020 ~~1990-~~  
 23           ~~1991~~ budget year must be given in the manner prescribed in  
 24           subsection (2) of Section 16. Thereafter, notice must be given  
 25           by publication in a newspaper of general circulation in Brevard

26 County at least 7 days before the date of the hearing. The  
27 stormwater management user fee, when established, shall be  
28 deemed to be reasonable and necessary to carry out the  
29 obligations, responsibilities, and duties of the District. All  
30 of the proceeds of the fee are in payment for the use of the  
31 District stormwater management system. The fee must be  
32 established by resolution of the Board of Directors and approved  
33 by a super-majority ~~majority~~ vote of the Board of County  
34 Commissioners of Brevard County, with one ~~each~~ County  
35 Commissioner whose county commission residency area lies wholly  
36 or partially within the District voting in the affirmative.

37 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
