Amendment (with title amendment)

Remove lines 159-176 and insert:

(6) ELIGIBLE IMPORTERS; NOTICE.-

(a) The following entities may import prescription drugs
from a Canadian supplier under the program:

1. A pharmacist or wholesaler employed by or under
contract with the department's central pharmacy, for
distribution to a county health department or free clinic for
dispensing to clients treated in such department or clinic.

2. A pharmacist or wholesaler employed by or under
contract with a Medicaid pharmacy, for dispensing to the
pharmacy's Medicaid recipients.

16 3. A pharmacist or wholesaler employed by or under
17 contract with the Department of Corrections, for dispensing to
18 inmates in the custody of the Department of Corrections.

19 4. A pharmacist or wholesaler employed by or under
20 contract with a developmental disabilities center, as defined in
21 s. 393.063, for dispensing to clients treated in such center.

22 5. A pharmacist or wholesaler employed by or under
23 contract with a treatment facility, as defined in s. 394.455,
24 for dispensing to patients treated in such facility.

25 (b) Due to the danger and risk associated with untested
26 prescription drugs imported under the program, the following
27 individuals may not be forced to participate in the program and
28 must be given an opportunity to opt out of the program:

29 1. An individual 65 years of age or older.

30 2. A psychiatric patient who is stable on his or her
31 current prescribed medications.

32 3. A pregnant woman or minor child participating in the
33 Medicaid program.

34 4. An inmate in the custody of the Department of
35 Corrections.

36 5. An individual with a developmental disability.

37 (c) Any individual who participates in the program under
38 this section must be notified that he or she is receiving
39 prescription drugs from outside of the United States and that
