Remove lines 20-37 and insert:

7 (b) The annual use fees shall be distributed to the City
 8 of Fort Pierce, subject to a city resolution designating the
 9 city as the fiscal agent of the license plate. The city may use
 10 up to 10 percent of the fees for administrative costs and
 11 marketing of the plate and shall use the remainder of the fees
 12 as follows:

13 1. Before completion of construction of the Highwaymen
 14 Museum and African-American Cultural Center, the city shall
 15 distribute at least 15 percent to the St. Lucie Education
 16 Foundation, Inc., to fund art education and art projects in

17 public schools within St. Lucie County. The remainder of the
18 fees shall be used by the city to fund the construction of the
19 Highwaymen Museum and African-American Cultural Center.

20 2. Upon completion of construction of the Highwaymen
21 Museum and African-American Cultural Center, the city shall
22 distribute at least 10 percent to the St. Lucie Education
23 Foundation, Inc., to fund art education and art projects in
24 public schools within St. Lucie County. The remainder of the
25 fees shall be used by the city to fund the day-to-day operations
26 of the Highwaymen Museum and African-American Cultural Center.
