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17       3. A college or university student, from 18 years of age  
18 to 23 years of age, who obtains a vaccination from a college or  
19 university student health center or clinic in the state may  
20 refuse to be included in the immunization registry by signing a  
21 form obtained from the department, health center, or clinic  
22 which indicates that the student does not wish to be included in  
23 the immunization registry. The student must provide such opt-out  
24 form to health center or clinic upon administration of the  
25 vaccination. Such health center or clinic shall submit the form  
26 to the department. A student may submit the opt-out form  
27 directly to the department. Any records or identifying  
28 information pertaining to the student shall be removed from the  
29 registry if the student has refused to be included in the  
30 immunization registry.

32 immunization records to be electronically available ~~transferred~~  
33 to entities that are required by law to have such records,  
34 including, but not limited to, schools and ~~7~~ licensed child care

37       5.4. A Any health care practitioner licensed under chapter  
38 458, chapter 459, or chapter 464 in this state who administers  
39 vaccinations or causes vaccinations to be administered to  
40 children from birth through 17 years of age is required to  
41 report vaccination data to the immunization registry, unless a

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42 parent or guardian of a child has refused to have the child  
43 included in the immunization registry by meeting the  
44 requirements of subparagraph 2. A health care practitioner  
45 licensed under chapter 458, chapter 459, or chapter 464 in this  
46 state who administers vaccinations or causes vaccinations to be  
47 administered to college or university students from 18 years of  
48 age to 23 years of age at a college or university student health  
49 center or clinic is required to report vaccination data to the  
50 immunization registry, unless the student has refused to be  
51 included in the immunization registry by meeting the  
52 requirements of subparagraph 3. Vaccination data for students in  
53 other age ranges may be submitted to the immunization registry  
54 only if the student consents to inclusion in the immunization  
55 registry. The upload of data from existing automated systems is  
56 an acceptable method for updating immunization information in
