- (2) The Articulation Coordinating Committee shall convene a workgroup by August 31, 2019, to develop a uniform methodology for determining when military experience is appropriate for postsecondary credit and to meet the requirements of this section.
- (a) The workgroup shall be composed of the following 13 members:
- 1. The chair of the Articulation Coordinating Committee, who shall serve as chair.
- 2. Four members representing academic affairs administrators and faculty from state universities, appointed by the chair of the Board of Governors.
- 3. Four members representing academic affairs administrators and faculty from Florida College System institutions, appointed by the chair of the State Board of Education.
- 4. Two members representing faculty from career centers, appointed by the chair of the State Board of Education.
- 5. Two members representing veterans, appointed by the executive director of the Department of Veterans' Affairs.
- (b) The Office of K-20 Articulation shall provide administrative support for the workgroup.

- (d) The Articulation Coordinating Committee shall facilitate the review of military experience and credentials for postsecondary course equivalencies and the amount of credit that must be awarded beginning no later than January 1, 2020, in accordance with the approved process.
- (e) The Articulation Coordinating Committee shall approve a list of postsecondary course equivalencies and the minimum credit that must be awarded for military experience and credentials no later than November 30, 2020, and annually thereafter. The Board of Governors and the State Board of Education shall adopt the list approved by the Articulation Coordinating Committee at the next publicly noticed meeting of each board.
- institutions, and career centers must award postsecondary credit for military credentials and experience based on the list adopted by the Board of Governors and the State Board of Education, if the credit is applicable toward the student's degree or certificate. Institutions may award additional

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postsecondary credit if appropriate. Credit awarded in accordance with minimum credit requirements is guaranteed to transfer to other state universities, Florida College System institutions, and career centers as if the credit were earned at the receiving institution.
