8 SECTION 5. Amendment or revision election.—

9 (a) A proposed amendment to or revision of this
10 constitution, or any part of it, shall be submitted to the
11 electors at the next general election held more than ninety days
12 after either the effective date of the joint resolution
13 proposing it or the date the report of revision commission,
14 constitutional convention or taxation and budget reform
15 commission proposal proposing it is filed with the custodian of
16 state records, unless, pursuant to law enacted by the

17 affirmative vote of three-fourths of the membership of each
18 house of the legislature and limited to a single amendment or
19 revision, it is submitted at an earlier special election held
20 more than ninety days after such filing.

21 (b) A proposed amendment or revision of this constitution,
22 or any part of it, by initiative shall be submitted to the
23 electors at the general election provided the initiative
24 petition is filed with the custodian of state records no later
25 than February 1 of the year in which the general election is
26 held.

27 (c) The legislature shall provide by general law, prior to
28 the holding of an election pursuant to this section, for the
29 provision of a statement to the public regarding the probable
30 financial impact of any amendment proposed by initiative
31 pursuant to section 3.

32 (d) Once in the tenth week, and once in the sixth week
33 immediately preceding the week in which the election is held,
34 the proposed amendment or revision, with notice of the date of
35 election at which it will be submitted to the electors, shall be
36 published in one newspaper of general circulation in each county
37 in which a newspaper is published.

38 (e) Unless otherwise specifically provided for elsewhere
39 in this constitution, if the proposed amendment or revision is
40 approved by vote of at least sixty percent of the electors
41 voting on the measure, it shall be effective as an amendment to

43 Tuesday after the first Monday in January following the
44 election, or on such other date as may be specified in the
45 amendment or revision.
