(d) Propose funding mechanisms for the development and maintenance of spaces for assisted and independent living facilities within mixed-use developments. (e) Propose an overall governing structure for managing spaces for assisted and independent living facilities within mixed-use developments. The task force shall submit a report by February 1, (6) 2020, to the Governor, the President of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives which includes its findings, conclusions, and recommendations. Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.

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
