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An act relating to the budgets of county constitutional officers; amending s. 129.03, F.S.; including property appraisers to the list of county constitutional officers who must submit a tentative budget to the board of county commissioners; providing criteria for submission of tentative and final budgets by county constitutional officers; requiring the tentative budget of a county constitutional officer to be separately identified from the tentative budget of the county as a whole when posted to the county's website; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (2) of section 129.03, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

129.03 Preparation and adoption of budget.-

(2) On or before June 1 of each year, the sheriff, the property appraiser, the clerk of the circuit court and county comptroller, the tax collector subject to a resolution entered into pursuant to s. 145.022(1), and the supervisor of elections shall each submit to the board of county commissioners a tentative budget for their respective offices for the ensuing fiscal year. However, the board of county commissioners may, by

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resolution, require the tentative budgets to be submitted by May 1 of each year. Each officer's tentative and final budget must be detailed and must provide a separate line item for proposed expenditures for each program, division, or unit within the office, and must include an identification of existing and proposed reserves. The tentative budget must be posted on the county's official website at least 2 days before the public hearing and must be identified separately from the tentative budget of the county as a whole to clearly demarcate the constitutional officers' budgets.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2019.
