Section 41. Subsection (1) of section 468.408, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

468.408 Bond required.—

(1) An owner or operator of a ~~There shall be filed with the department for each~~ talent agency shall obtain ~~license a~~ bond in the form of a surety by a reputable company engaged in the bonding business and authorized to do business in this state. The bond shall be for the penal sum of \$5,000, with one or more sureties ~~to be approved by the department,~~ and be conditioned that the owner or operator of the talent agency ~~applicant~~ conform to and not violate any of the duties, terms,

17 conditions, provisions, or requirements of this part. Such a
18 bond may not be issued or renewed unless the bonding agency has
19 performed an examination of the criminal history of each owner
20 or operator of such talent agency, after submission of
21 fingerprints to the Florida Department of Law Enforcement and
22 the Federal Bureau of Investigation, to verify that each owner
23 or operator has not been convicted of a crime that would require
24 registration as a sexual offender, as required in s. 943.0435 or
25 s. 944.607, or as a sexual predator, as required under s.
26 775.21.

27 (a) If any person is aggrieved by the misconduct of any
28 talent agency, the person may maintain an action in his or her
29 own name upon the bond of the agency in any court having
30 jurisdiction of the amount claimed. All such claims shall be
31 assignable, and the assignee shall be entitled to the same
32 remedies, upon the bond of the agency or otherwise, as the
33 person aggrieved would have been entitled to if such claim had
34 not been assigned. Any claim or claims so assigned may be
35 enforced in the name of such assignee.

36 (b) The bonding company shall notify the talent agency
37 ~~department~~ of any claim against such bond, and a copy of such
38 notice shall be sent to the talent agency against which the
39 claim is made.
