Such a 18 bond may not be issued or renewed unless the bonding agency has 19 performed an examination of the criminal history of each owner or operator of such talent agency, after submission of 20 21 fingerprints to the Florida Department of Law Enforcement and the Federal Bureau of Investigation, to verify that each owner 22 23 or operator has not been convicted of a crime that would require registration as a sexual offender, as required in s. 943.0435 or 24 s. 944.607, or as a sexual predator, as required under s. 25 26 775.21.

If any person is aggrieved by the misconduct of any 27 (a) 28 talent agency, the person may maintain an action in his or her 29 own name upon the bond of the agency in any court having jurisdiction of the amount claimed. All such claims shall be 30 assignable, and the assignee shall be entitled to the same 31 32 remedies, upon the bond of the agency or otherwise, as the 33 person aggrieved would have been entitled to if such claim had not been assigned. Any claim or claims so assigned may be 34 35 enforced in the name of such assignee.
