6 Remove lines 36-72 and insert:

7 Section 2. (1) The Legislature finds that it is a public
8 necessity that the portion of a meeting relating directly to or
9 that would reveal the following information, which is
10 confidential and exempt under s. 119.0713(5), Florida Statutes,
11 be made exempt from s. 286.011, Florida Statutes, and s. 24(b),
12 Art. I of the State Constitution. The Legislature further finds
13 the recording and transcript of such a meeting be made
14 confidential and exempt from disclosure under s. 119.07(1) and
15 s. 24(a), Art. I of the State Constitution.

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16 (a) Information related to the security of the technology,
17 processes, or practices of the utility that are designed to
18 protect the utility's networks, computers, programs, and data
19 from attack, damage, or unauthorized access, which information,
20 if disclosed, would facilitate the alteration, disclosure, or
21 destruction of such data or information technology resources.

22 (b) Information related to the security of existing or
23 proposed information technology systems or industrial control
24 technology systems of the utility, which, if disclosed, would
25 facilitate unauthorized access to, and alteration or destruction
26 of, such systems in a manner that would adversely impact the
27 safe and reliable operation of the systems and utility.

28 (2) The Legislature finds that, as utility system
29 infrastructure becomes more connected and integrated through
30 information and communications technology, the exposure to
31 damage from attacks through such technology grows. These attacks
32 may result in the disruption of utility services and damage to
33 utility systems. Maintaining safe and reliable utility systems
34 is vital to protecting the public health and safety and ensuring
35 the economic well-being of the state.

36 (3) The Legislature finds that the public and private harm
37 in disclosing the information made exempt by this act outweighs
38 any public benefit derived from the disclosure of such
39 information. The protection of information and communications
40 made exempt by this act will ensure that utilities have greater

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41 safeguards to protect against security threats and will bolster
42 efforts to develop more resilient information technology systems
43 and industrial control technology systems.

44 (4) Therefore, the Legislature finds that it is a public
45 necessity to make such information exempt from public meetings
46 requirements and the recording and transcript thereof
47 confidential and exempt from public records requirements.
