 2 An act relating to driver license, identification
 3 card, and motor vehicle registration applications;
 4 amending s. 320.02, F.S.; deleting a requirement that
 5 the application form for motor vehicle registration
 6 and renewal of registration include language
 7 permitting a voluntary contribution to the Auto Club
 8 Group Traffic Safety Foundation; requiring such form
 9 to include language permitting a voluntary
 10 contribution to the Live Like Bella Childhood Cancer
 11 Foundation; requiring the Department of Highway Safety
 12 and Motor Vehicles to distribute such contributions to
 13 the foundation; amending s. 322.08, F.S.; deleting a
 14 requirement that the application form for an original,
 15 renewal, or replacement driver license or
 16 identification card include language permitting a
 17 voluntary contribution to the Auto Club Group Traffic
 18 Safety Foundation; providing an effective date.

 20 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

 22 Section 1. Paragraph (u) of subsection (16) of section
 23 320.02, Florida Statutes, is redesignated as paragraph (t),
 24 present paragraph (t) is amended, and a new paragraph (u) is
 25 added to that subsection, to read:

26 320.02 Registration required; application for
 27 registration; forms.—

29 ~~(t) The application form for motor vehicle registration~~
 30 ~~and renewal registration must include language permitting a~~
 31 ~~voluntary contribution of \$1 or more per applicant, which shall~~
 32 ~~be distributed to the Auto Club Group Traffic Safety Foundation,~~
 33 ~~Inc., a nonprofit organization. Funds received by the foundation~~
 34 ~~must be used to improve traffic safety culture in communities~~
 35 ~~through effective outreach, education, and activities in the~~
 36 ~~state which will save lives, reduce injuries, and prevent~~
 37 ~~crashes. The foundation must comply with s. 320.023.~~

38 (u) Notwithstanding s. 320.023(1) and (2), the application
 39 form for motor vehicle registration and renewal of registration
 40 must include language permitting a voluntary contribution of \$1
 41 or more per applicant to the Live Like Bella Childhood Cancer
 42 Foundation. Such contributions must be distributed by the
 43 department to the Live Like Bella Childhood Cancer Foundation.

48 Section 2. Subsection (8) of section 322.08, Florida
 49 Statutes, is amended to read:

50 322.08 Application for license; requirements for license

51 and identification card forms.—

52 (8) The application form for an original, renewal, or
53 replacement driver license or identification card must include
54 language permitting the following:

55 (a) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant, which
56 contribution shall be deposited into the Health Care Trust Fund
57 for organ and tissue donor education and for maintaining the
58 organ and tissue donor registry.

59 (b) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant, which
60 shall be distributed to the Florida Council of the Blind.

61 (c) A voluntary contribution of \$2 per applicant, which
62 shall be distributed to the Hearing Research Institute,
63 Incorporated.

64 (d) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant, which
65 shall be distributed to the Juvenile Diabetes Foundation
66 International.

67 (e) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant, which
68 shall be distributed to the Children's Hearing Help Fund.

69 (f) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant, which
70 shall be distributed to Family First, a nonprofit organization.

71 (g) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant to Stop
72 Heart Disease, which shall be distributed to the Florida Heart
73 Research Institute, a nonprofit organization.

74 (h) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant to Senior
75 Vision Services, which shall be distributed to the Florida

76 Association of Agencies Serving the Blind, Inc., a not-for-
 77 profit organization.

78 (i) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant for
 79 services for persons with developmental disabilities, which
 80 shall be distributed to The Arc of Florida.

81 (j) A voluntary contribution of \$1 to the Ronald McDonald
 82 House, which shall be distributed each month to Ronald McDonald
 83 House Charities of Tampa Bay, Inc.

84 (k) Notwithstanding s. 322.081, a voluntary contribution
 85 of \$1 per applicant, which shall be distributed to the League
 86 Against Cancer/La Liga Contra el Cancer, a not-for-profit
 87 organization.

88 (l) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant to
 89 Prevent Child Sexual Abuse, which shall be distributed to
 90 Lauren's Kids, Inc., a nonprofit organization.

91 (m) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant, which
 92 shall be distributed to Prevent Blindness Florida, a not-for-
 93 profit organization, to prevent blindness and preserve the sight
 94 of the residents of this state.

95 (n) Notwithstanding s. 322.081, a voluntary contribution
 96 of \$1 per applicant to the state homes for veterans, to be
 97 distributed on a quarterly basis by the department to the
 98 Operations and Maintenance Trust Fund within the Department of
 99 Veterans' Affairs.

100 (o) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant to the

101 Disabled American Veterans, Department of Florida, which shall
 102 be distributed quarterly to Disabled American Veterans,
 103 Department of Florida, a nonprofit organization.

104 (p) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant for
 105 Autism Services and Supports, which shall be distributed to
 106 Achievement and Rehabilitation Centers, Inc., Autism Services
 107 Fund.

108 (q) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant to
 109 Support Our Troops, which shall be distributed to Support Our
 110 Troops, Inc., a Florida not-for-profit organization.

111 ~~(r) A voluntary contribution of \$1 or more per applicant,~~
 112 ~~which shall be distributed to the Auto Club Group Traffic Safety~~
 113 ~~Foundation, Inc., a not-for-profit organization.~~

114 (r)~~(s)~~ Notwithstanding s. 322.081, a voluntary
 115 contribution of \$1 per applicant to aid the homeless.
 116 Contributions made pursuant to this paragraph shall be deposited
 117 into the Grants and Donations Trust Fund of the Department of
 118 Children and Families and used by the State Office on
 119 Homelessness to supplement grants made under s. 420.622(4) and
 120 (5), provide information to the public about homelessness in the
 121 state, and provide literature for homeless persons seeking
 122 assistance.

 124 applicant to End Breast Cancer, which shall be distributed to
 125 the Florida Breast Cancer Foundation.

127 A statement providing an explanation of the purpose of the trust

130 under paragraphs (b)-(s) ~~(b)-(t)~~ are not income of a revenue
