32	3. A day on which a member of the United States Armed
33	Forces who is a resident of this state loses his or her life in
34	the line of duty.
35	(c) In a manner designed to ensure visibility to the
36	public.
37	(d) With no more than two additional flags when displayed
38	together on a flagpole.
39	(3) A flag displayed pursuant to this section must be
40	manufactured in the United States.
41	(4) A local government may display the flag in accordance
42	with paragraphs (2)(b), (c), and (d) at any local government
43	building at which the United States flag is displayed and at any
44	other local government location it deems appropriate.
45	(5) By July 1, 2020, a department or an agency responsible
46	for a location specified in paragraph (2)(a), or a local
47	government pursuant to subsection (4), may adopt regulations as
48	necessary to carry out this section. Such regulations may not
49	require an employee to report to work solely to display the
50	<u>flag.</u>
