DELETE the proviso immediately following Specific Appropriation 349:

From the funds in Specific Appropriation 349, the nonrecurring sums of \$3,303,191 from the General Revenue fund and \$3,003,810 from the Federal Grants Trust Fund are provided to continue the existing contract for automated commercial wage verification services for the purpose of acquiring current employment and income information for eligibility determination and periodic recertification for the following public

benefit programs: Supplemental Nutrition Assistance (SNAP), Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF), and Medicaid. Funds shall be used to automate the eligibility determination process, to improve program integrity and to detect and deter fraud, waste, and abuse in public benefit programs administered by the Department of Children and Families (HB 9151).

At the end of existing proviso language, following Specific Appropriation 450, INSERT:

From funds in Specific Appropriation 450, \$3,303,191 from the General Revenue Fund and \$3,303,810 from the Federal Grants Trust Fund is provided to the Covering Kids & Families Program at the University of South Florida to issue navigator grants to facilitate and promote health insurance coverage for uninsured Floridians under the Affordable Care Act.

Line item amendments are accepted as part of the amendatory process. However, due to the necessity of using computerized systems this may entail a different placement within a budget entity or the renumbering of the specific appropriation items.
