5 Remove everything after the enacting clause and insert:
 6 Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subsection (4) of section 493.6303,
 7 Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

8 493.6303 License requirements.—In addition to the license
 9 requirements set forth elsewhere in this chapter, each
 10 individual or agency must comply with the following additional
 11 requirements:

12 (4) (a) An applicant for a Class "D" license must submit
 13 proof of successful completion of a minimum of 40 hours of
 14 professional training at a school or training facility licensed
 15 by the department. Such training may be conducted by in-person
 16 instruction or online through a secure website of the school or

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17 facility, provided that the applicant's identity, attendance,
18 and successful completion of training are verified, and such
19 verification is provided to the department upon completion of
20 the training. The department shall by rule, and in accordance
21 with s. 493.6103, establish the general content, ~~and~~ number of
22 hours of each subject area to be taught, the method of delivery
23 and the security protocols for online training and testing, the
24 reporting requirements for verification of successful completion
25 of training, and any other rules necessary for the regulation of
26 schools providing in-person or online training.

27 Section 2. Paragraphs (a) and (b) of subsection (2) of
28 section 493.6304, Florida Statutes, are amended to read:

29 493.6304 Security officer school or training facility.—

30 (2) The application shall be signed and verified by the
31 applicant under oath as provided in s. 92.525 and must contain,
32 at a minimum, the following information:

33 (a) The name and address of the school or training
34 facility, or, if the training is conducted online, the name and
35 website address of the school or facility, and, if the applicant
36 is an individual, her or his name, address, and social security
37 or alien registration number.

38 (b) The street address or website address of the place at
39 which the training is to be conducted.

40 Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2019.
