An act relating to Halifax Hospital Med

An act relating to Halifax Hospital Medical Center, Volusia County; providing legislative intent; amending chapter 2003-374, Laws of Florida; confirming the district has the authority to establish, construct, operate, and maintain hospitals, facilities, and services within and beyond the boundaries of the district; specifying that ad valorem taxes be levied and expended within the boundaries of the district; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. It is the intent of the Legislature in enacting this act to clarify and confirm that section 5 of chapter 2003-374, Laws of Florida, as previously adopted, authorizes the district to operate facilities and provide services both within and beyond the geographic taxing boundaries of the district.

Section 2. Section 5 of chapter 2003-374, Laws of Florida, is amended to read:

Section 5. The district may establish, construct, operate, and maintain such hospitals, medical facilities, and other health care facilities and services as are necessary, both within and beyond the boundaries of the district. Ad valorem taxes shall not be levied outside the boundaries of the district

and ad valorem tax revenue shall not be expended or pledged for services or facilities outside the boundaries of the district.

There shall be no restrictions on the expenditure of non-ad valorem revenues. The hospitals, medical facilities, and other health care facilities and services shall be established, constructed, operated, and maintained by the district for the preservation of the public health, for the public good, and for the use of the public; and of the district. maintenance of such hospitals, medical facilities, and other health care facilities and services inside and outside in the district is hereby found and declared to be a public purpose and necessary for the general welfare of the public residents of the district.

Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
