(2) A person who experiences, or has a good faith belief that he or she is experiencing, an alcohol or a drug-related overdose and is in need of medical assistance may not be arrested, charged, prosecuted, or penalized pursuant to this chapter for a violation of s. 893.147(1) or s. 893.13(6), excluding paragraph (c), possession of a controlled substance if the evidence for such offense possession of a controlled substance substance was obtained as a result of the person's seeking the overdose and the need for medical assistance.
