

1 A bill to be entitled
 2 An act relating to specialty license plates; amending
 3 s. 320.08058, F.S.; directing the Department of
 4 Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles to develop a Sun Sea
 5 Smiles license plate; providing for distribution and
 6 use of fees collected from the sale of the plates;
 7 providing a contingent effective date.
 8

9 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

 11 Section 1. Subsection (84) is added to section 320.08058,
 12 Florida Statutes, to read:

13 320.08058 Specialty license plates.—

14 (84) SUN SEA SMILES LICENSE PLATES.—

15 (a) The department shall develop a Sun Sea Smiles license
 16 plate as provided in this section and s. 320.08053. The plate
 17 must bear the colors and design approved by the department. The
 18 word "Florida" must appear at the top of the plate, and the
 19 words "Sun Sea Smiles" must appear at the bottom of the plate.

20 (b) The annual use fees from the sale of the plate shall
 21 be distributed as follows:

22 1. Five percent shall be distributed to the Florida
 23 Caribbean Charitable Foundation, Inc., to be used for marketing
 24 of the Sun Sea Smiles license plate.

25 2. Thirty percent shall be distributed to the Florida
26 Caribbean Charitable Foundation, Inc. Of this amount, up to 5
27 percent may be used for administrative expenses, and the
28 remainder shall be used as follows:

29 a. Sixty percent shall be used for a college scholarship
30 program.

31 b. Fifteen percent shall be used to promote health and
32 wellness among Florida residents of Caribbean descent.

33 c. Twenty-five percent shall be used to promote awareness
34 of Caribbean culture within the state.

35 3. Twenty percent shall be distributed to the American
36 Friends of Jamaica, Inc., a charitable, not-for-profit
37 organization under s. 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code
38 registered with the Department of Agriculture and Consumer
39 Services and incorporated in New York, to be used for grants to
40 promote social and community development among Florida
41 residents. Of this amount, up to 5 percent may be used for
42 administrative and marketing expenses.

43 4. Ten percent shall be distributed to Sant La Haitian
44 Neighborhood Center, Inc., to be used for promoting social and
45 community development. Of this amount, up to 5 percent may be
46 used for administrative expenses.

47 5. Ten percent shall be distributed to Fanm Ayisyen nan
48 Miyami, Inc., to be used for promoting social and community

49 development. Of this amount, up to 10 percent may be used for
50 administrative expenses.

51 6. Twenty percent shall be distributed to Greater
52 Caribbean American Cultural Coalition, Inc., to be used for
53 promoting awareness of Caribbean culture within the state. Of
54 this amount, up to 5 percent may be used for administrative
55 expenses.

56 7. Five percent shall be distributed to Little Haiti
57 Optimist Foundation, Inc., to be used for promoting awareness of
58 Caribbean culture and youth development within the state. Of
59 this amount, up to 5 percent may be used for administrative
60 expenses.

61 Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2019, but
62 only if HB 621 or similar legislation takes effect, if such
63 legislation is adopted in the same legislative session or an
64 extension thereof and becomes a law.
