7 (4) (a) In accordance with each county's obligation under s.
8 14, Art. V of the State Constitution and s. 29.008 to fund
9 security for trial court facilities, the sheriff of each county
10 shall coordinate with the board of county commissioners of that
11 county and the chief judge of the circuit in which that county
12 is located on the development of a comprehensive plan for the
13 provision of security for trial court facilities. Each sheriff
14 shall retain authority over the implementation and provision of
15 law enforcement services associated with the plan. The chief
16 judge of the circuit shall retain decision-making authority to

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17 ensure the protection of due process rights, including, but not
18 limited to, the scheduling and conduct of trial and other
19 judicial proceedings, as part of his or her responsibility for
20 the administrative supervision of trial courts under s. 43.26.
