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2	An act for the relief of Jorge L. Dominguez, Chelsea									
3	Beatrice Dominguez, Brittney Delores Dominguez, and									
4	Tori Alexis Dominguez by Hillsborough County;									
5	providing for an appropriation to compensate them for									
6	the wrongful death of Darcia Lynn Dominguez, which									
7	occurred as the result of the negligence of									
8	Hillsborough County and one of its employees;									
9	providing a limitation on the payment of compensation,									
10	attorney fees, lobbying fees, and costs; providing an									
11	effective date.

13	WHEREAS, on February 6, 2010, Darcia Lynn Dominguez, a 39-									
14	year-old licensed registered nurse, was driving northbound on									
15	Veterans Expressway in Tampa, and									
16	WHEREAS, on the morning in question, Santiago Hasbun, an									
17	employee of Hillsborough County, acting in the regular course									
18	and scope of his employment duties and with the express consent									
19	of Hillsborough County, was operating a tractor-trailer owned by									
20	Hillsborough County northbound on Veterans Expressway, and									
21	WHEREAS, Mr. Hasbun negligently operated the tractor-									
22	trailer when he failed to remove the vehicle from the traveled									
23	portion of the highway despite a warning from the vehicle									
24	management and control system of impending engine failure, which									
25	warning continued for a period of at least 15 minutes before the									
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26 engine shut down, and despite the availability of a 24-foot to 27 37-foot grass median onto to which he could have traveled and 28 parked the tractor-trailer, and

29 WHEREAS, Mr. Hasbun violated Florida law by failing to 30 timely exit the tractor-trailer or to remove it from the 31 traveled portion of the roadway prior to the engine breakdown 32 and, thereafter, by failing to warn approaching motorists of the 33 hazard posed by the vehicle by not placing statutorily required 34 emergency triangles or cones in the proper location at the rear of the vehicle, the purpose of such placement being to apprise 35 approaching motorists of the hazard at a sufficient distance to 36 37 allow them to stop or take evasive action, and

38 WHEREAS, Hillsborough County, through its Fleet Management 39 Department, was negligent in its servicing and maintenance of 40 the tractor-trailer driven by Mr. Hasbun, which resulted in an 41 electrical failure, which prevented the operation of the 42 tractor-trailer's emergency flashing lights, and

WHEREAS, the combined negligence of Hillsborough County and its employee, Mr. Hasbun, proximately caused Ms. Dominguez to crash into the back of the tractor-trailer, which had come to a complete stop on the traveled portion of the roadway, and

WHEREAS, at the time of her death as a result of the crash, Ms. Dominguez was the spouse of Jorge L. Dominguez and the mother of their three daughters, Tori Alexis Dominguez, then 10 years of age; Brittney Delores Dominguez, then 16 years of age;

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and Chelsea Beatrice Dominguez, then 18 years of age, and WHEREAS, in accordance with the Wrongful Death Act, Mr. Dominguez commenced a legal action against Hillsborough County in Tampa on behalf of the Estate of Darcia Lynn Dominguez and her surviving spouse and daughters, and

56 WHEREAS, after years of litigation, Hillsborough County on 57 December 13, 2016, acknowledged its negligence and that of its 58 employee and entered into a consent judgment for \$600,000, of 59 which Hillsborough County has paid its sovereign immunity limit 60 of \$200,000, and

WHEREAS, in a separate, confidential settlement, the 61 62 county's excess insurance carrier, Star Insurance Company, paid an additional, confidential amount to the plaintiff and, by 63 64 virtue of the consent judgment and the settlement agreement reached between the parties, Hillsborough County has agreed that 65 it is liable to the Estate of Darcia Lynn Dominguez for an 66 67 additional \$400,000 in damages, to be paid in two equal installments over the course of 2 years, with the first \$200,000 68 69 payment to be made during the October following the effective 70 date of this act, and the second \$200,000 payment to be made 71 during October of the immediately following year, and

72 WHEREAS, Hillsborough County has acknowledged that a 73 reasonable estimate of the damages recoverable for the four 74 statutory survivors of Ms. Dominguez is between \$4 million and 75 \$8 million and forensic estimates of her lifetime earnings,

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76	recoverable as damages for loss of net accumulations to her
77	estate, amounted to an additional \$1.7 million, and
78	WHEREAS, Hillsborough County consents to and fully supports
79	the passage of this act, NOW, THEREFORE,
80	
81	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:
82	
83	Section 1. The facts stated in the preamble to this act
84	are found and declared to be true.
85	Section 2. Hillsborough County is authorized and directed
86	to appropriate from funds not otherwise encumbered and to draw
87	two warrants in the sum of \$200,000 each, payable to the Estate
88	of Darcia Lynn Dominguez. The first \$200,000 shall be paid
89	during the October following the effective date of this act, and
90	the second \$200,000 shall be paid during October of the
91	immediately following year.
92	Section 3. The amount paid by Hillsborough County pursuant
93	to s. 768.28, Florida Statutes, and the amount awarded under
94	this act are intended to provide the sole compensation for all
95	present and future claims arising out of the factual situation
96	described in this act which resulted in the death of Darcia Lynn
97	Dominguez. Of the amount awarded under this act, the total
98	amount paid for attorney fees may not exceed \$100,000, no amount
99	may be paid for lobbying fees, and the total amount paid for
100	costs or other similar expenses may not exceed \$5,892.83.
