22	followed, the tests performed, the information obtained, and the

25	(2) PUBLIC RECORDS EXEMPTION.—The following information

(d) To a liquidator, receiver, or conservator for a family 67 68 trust company, licensed family trust company, or foreign 69 licensed family trust company if a liquidator, receiver, or 70 conservator is appointed. or committee that receives records or information pursuant to

records or information, except in a case involving the
