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Representative Fernández offered the following:

Substitute Amendment for Amendment (086189)

Between lines 164 and 165, insert:

3. Private schools that have enrolled 30 or more Florida Tax Credit Scholarship or Florida Empowerment Scholarship recipients, be precluded from enrolling additional Florida Tax Credit Scholarship or Florida Empowerment Scholarship recipients in any subsequent academic year if the private school's most recent academic average gain score, as documented in the most recent annual evaluation by the Learning Systems Institute at Florida State University, indicates a negative average gain score, combined for reading and math, during the most recent 3-

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14 year period as evaluated by the institute. Such private school
15 may, thereafter, only be authorized to enroll additional Florida
16 Tax Credit Scholarship or Florida Empowerment Scholarship
17 recipients in an academic year immediately following the earlier
18 of either:
19 a. Two consecutive academic years of positive average gain
20 scores, reading and math combined, by such private school; or
21 b. A positive average gain score, reading and math
22 combined, for such private school during its most recent 3-year
23 period.

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
