## Senate Amendment

and insert:
representative" means a client's legal guardian or, if the client is younger than 18 years old, the client's parent or legal guardian.
(2) (a) Within 14 working days after receiving a written request from a former or current client or that client's legal representative, a provider shall furnish a true and correct copy

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of all records, including medical, care and treatment, and
interdisciplinary records, as applicable to that client, in the
possession of the provider.
(b) If a provider maintains a system of electronic health
records as defined in s. 408.051 , the provider shall furnish the
requested records in the manner chosen by the requester, which
may include paper documents, electronic format, access through a
web-based patient portal, or submission through a client's
electronic personal health record.
(3) Within 10 working days after receiving such a request
by a former or current client or that client's legal
representative, a provider shall provide access to examine the
original records, microforms, or other suitable reproductions of
the records in its possession. A provider may impose any
reasonable terms necessary to ensure that the records will not
be damaged, destroyed, or altered.
(4) A provider may charge the requester no more than the reasonable costs of reproducing the records, including reasonable staff time. Such charges apply to all records
