Section 1. Subsection (1) of section 40.013, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

40.013 Persons disqualified or excused from jury service.-

(1) No person who is under prosecution for any crime, or who has been convicted in this state, any federal court, or any other state, territory, or country of bribery, forgery, perjury, larceny, or any other offense that is a felony in this state or



12 which if it had been committed in this state would be a felony, 13 unless restored to civil rights, shall be qualified to serve as 14 a juror. However, the disqualification provided under this 15 subsection no longer applies upon the restoration of voting 16 rights pursuant to s. 4., Art.
