Eligible charter schools are entitled to a 15 16 proportionate share of district funding. Funds At least 90 17 percent of a district's allocation must be expended only on the 18 elements specified in paragraph (b) subparagraphs (b)1. and 2. 19 The allocated funds may not supplant funds that are provided for 20 this purpose from other operating funds and may not be used to 21 increase salaries or provide bonuses. School districts are 22 encouraged to maximize third party health insurance benefits and Medicaid claiming for services, where appropriate. 23

(a) Before the distribution of the allocation:

25 1. The school district must develop and submit a detailed 26 plan outlining the local program and planned expenditures to the 27 district school board for approval.

28 2. A charter school must develop and submit a detailed 29 plan outlining the local program and planned expenditures to its 30 governing body for approval. After the plan is approved by the 31 governing body, it must be provided to the charter school's 32 sponsor.

33 (b) The plans required under paragraph (a) must be focused 34 on delivering evidence-based mental health care treatment to 35 children and include the following elements:

Provision of mental health assessment, diagnosis,
intervention, treatment, and recovery services to students with
