**Amendment (with title amendment)**

Remove lines 606-631 and insert:

(a) An application proposing to create a Coach Aaron Feis Guardian Program at a public school or charter school may be made by a district school board, principal, teacher, parent, or school advisory council of such public or charter school. Such application shall be submitted to a district school board and shall demonstrate the support of at least 50 percent of the teachers employed at the school and 50 percent of the parents whose children are enrolled at the school, provided that a majority of the parents eligible to vote participate in the

14 ballot process, according to rules adopted by the State Board of  
15 Education. If a district school board denies an application  
16 proposing to create such guardian program, the district school  
17 board shall provide notice of such denial to the applicant in  
18 writing within 10 days after the meeting at which the district  
19 school board denied the application. Such notice must articulate  
20 in writing the specific reasons for denial and must provide  
21 documentation supporting those reasons.

22 (b) A school guardian has no authority to act in any law  
23 enforcement capacity except to the extent necessary to prevent  
24 or abate an active assailant incident on school premises.  
25 Individuals who serve as school guardians are in support of  
26 school-sanctioned activities for purposes of s. 790.115. School  
27 guardians shall:

28 1. Hold a valid license issued under s. 790.06 or a Class  
29 "D" and "G" license pursuant to chapter 493;

30 2. Successfully complete the training for school guardians  
31 required under s. 943.1712;

32 3. Pass a psychological evaluation administered by a  
33 psychologist licensed under chapter 490 and designated by the  
34 Department of Law Enforcement and submit the results of the  
35 evaluation to the sheriff's office. The Department of Law  
36 Enforcement is authorized to provide the district school board  
37 or governing board of the charter school with mental health and  
38 substance abuse data for compliance with this subparagraph; and
