Between lines 425 and 426, insert:

(7) FACILITIES.—

(d) No later than January 1 ~~October 1~~, the department ~~each~~
~~school district~~ shall annually provide to school districts ~~the~~
~~Department of Education~~ a list of all underused, vacant, or
 surplus facilities owned or operated by the school district as
reported in the Florida Inventory of School Houses. A school
district may provide evidence to the department within 30 days
that the list contains errors or omissions. No later than April
1, annually, the department shall publish a final list of all
underused, vacant, or surplus facilities owned or operated by
each school district. A hope operator establishing a school of

17 hope may use an educational facility identified in this
18 paragraph at no cost or at a mutually agreeable cost not to
19 exceed \$600 per student. A hope operator using a facility
20 pursuant to this paragraph may not sell or dispose of such
21 facility without the written permission of the school district.
22 For purposes of this paragraph, the term "underused, vacant, or
23 surplus facility" means an entire facility or portion thereof
24 which is not fully used or is used irregularly or intermittently
25 by the school district for instructional or program use.
