7 Section 22. Subsection (2) of section 102.111, Florida
 8 Statutes, is amended to read:

9 102.111 Elections Canvassing Commission.—

10 (2) The Elections Canvassing Commission shall meet at 9
 11 a.m. on the 9th day after a primary election to certify the
 12 returns for each federal, state, and multicounty office. The
 13 commission shall meet ~~and~~ at 9 a.m. on the 14th day after a
 14 general election to certify the returns of the election for each
 15 ~~federal, state, and multicounty office. The commission shall~~
 16 meet at 9 a.m. on the 21st day after a general election to

17 certify the returns for each federal and state office. If a
18 member of a county canvassing board that was constituted
19 pursuant to s. 102.141 determines, within 5 days after the
20 certification by the Elections Canvassing Commission, that a
21 typographical error occurred in the official returns of the
22 county, the correction of which could result in a change in the
23 outcome of an election, the county canvassing board must certify
24 corrected returns to the Department of State within 24 hours,
25 and the Elections Canvassing Commission must correct and
26 recertify the election returns as soon as practicable.

27 Section 23. Subsection (2) of section 102.112, Florida
28 Statutes, is amended to read:

29 102.112 Deadline for submission of county returns to the
30 Department of State.—

31 (2) Returns must be filed by 5 p.m. on the 7th day
32 following a primary election, ~~and~~ by noon on the 12th day
33 following the general election for multicounty offices, and by
34 noon on January 1 of the year following the general election for
35 federal and statewide offices. However, the Department of State
36 may correct typographical errors, including the transposition of
37 numbers, in any returns submitted to the Department of State
38 pursuant to s. 102.111(2).
