Amendment

5 Remove everything after the enacting clause and insert:

6 Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subsection (3) of section
 7 934.50, Florida Statutes, is amended; paragraphs (d) through (j)
 8 of subsection (4) are redesignated as paragraphs (h) through
 9 (d), respectively; and new paragraphs (d), (e), (f), and (g) are
 10 added to that subsection, to read:

11 934.50 Searches and seizure using a drone.—

12 (3) Prohibited use of drones.—

13 (a) A law enforcement agency may not use a drone to gather
 14 evidence or other information, except as provided in paragraph
 15 (4).

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16 (4) EXCEPTIONS.—This section does not prohibit the use of
17 a drone:

18 (d) To assist a law enforcement agency in crowd control
19 involving a group of 50 people or more.

20 (e) To assist a law enforcement agency with traffic
21 management, except that a law enforcement agency may not use a
22 drone to gather evidence for traffic infraction enforcement.

23 (f) To facilitate a law enforcement agency's collection of
24 evidence at a crime scene or traffic crash scene.

25 (g) By a state agency or political subdivision for the
26 assessment of damage due to a flood, wildfire, or natural
27 disaster or for vegetation or wildlife management on publicly
28 owned land or water.

29 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2019.
