House Resolution

A resolution recognizing Florida's military and veteran caregivers, also known as "Hidden Heroes."

WHEREAS, as documented by a RAND Corporation study commissioned by the Elizabeth Dole Foundation, the series of wars and conflicts in which the United States has been engaged since World War II has resulted in 5.5 million parents, spouses, siblings, and friends who are caregivers to wounded, ill, or injured servicemembers and veterans, and

WHEREAS, the daily tasks of these caregivers may include bathing, dressing, feeding, caring for grievous injuries, administering medications, and providing emotional support to servicemembers and veterans in addition to caring for the family and the home while also working outside the home to earn essential income, and

WHEREAS, the United States provides multifaceted support to wounded, ill, and injured servicemembers and veterans through public, private, and philanthropic resources, but caregivers receive little support or acknowledgement, and according to research, an alarming number of military and veteran caregivers suffer numerous debilitating mental, physical, and emotional effects as a result of their caregiving duties, and

WHEREAS, the Elizabeth Dole Foundation established the Hidden Heroes program, the mission of which is to raise

awareness of the issues military and veteran caregivers confront daily and to inspire individuals, businesses, and community leaders to take action in supporting these caregivers in their communities, and

WHEREAS, Alachua County, Gainesville, Jacksonville, and Winter Springs are currently registered as Hidden Heroes Communities, a growing nationwide network of cities and counties dedicated to recognizing and supporting local military and veteran caregivers, NOW, THEREFORE,
