Between lines 274 and 275, insert:

Section 7. Subsection (6) is added to section 1002.21, Florida Statutes, to read:

1002.21 Postsecondary student and parent rights.—

(6) ANTI-SEMITISM.—A public postsecondary educational institution must treat discrimination by students or employees or resulting from institutional policies motivated by anti-Semitic intent in an identical manner to discrimination motivated by race. For purposes of this subsection, the term "anti-Semitism" includes a certain perception of the Jewish

14 people, which may be expressed as hatred toward Jewish people,
15 retorical and physical manifestations of anti-Semitism directed
16 toward a person, his or her property, or toward Jewish community
17 institutions or religious facilities.

18 (a) Examples of anti-Semitism include:

19 1. Calling for, aiding, or justifying the killing or
20 harming of Jews, often in the name of a radical ideology or an
21 extremist view of religion.

22 2. Making mendacious, dehumanizing, demonizing, or
23 stereotypical allegations about Jews as such or the power of
24 Jews as a collective, especially, but not exclusively, the myth
25 about a world Jewish conspiracy or of Jews controlling the
26 media, economy, government, or other societal institutions.

27 3. Accusing Jews as a people of being responsible for real
28 or imagined wrongdoing committed by a single Jewish person or
29 group, the State of Israel, or even for acts committed by non-
30 Jews.

31 4. Accusing Jews as a people or the State of Israel of
32 inventing or exaggerating the Holocaust.

33 5. Accusing Jewish citizens of being more loyal to Israel,
34 or the alleged priorities of Jews worldwide, than to the
35 interest of their own nations.

36 (b) Examples of anti-Semitism related to Israel include:

37 1. Demonizing Israel by using the symbols and images
38 associated with classic anti-Semitism to characterize Israel or

39 Israelis, drawing comparisons of contemporary Israeli policy to
40 that of the Nazis, or blaming Israel for all inter-religious or
41 political tensions.

42 2. Applying a double standard to Israel by requiring
43 behavior of Israel that is not expected or demanded of any other
44 democratic nation, or focusing peace or human rights
45 investigations only on Israel.

46 3. Delegitimizing Israel by denying the Jewish people
47 their right to self-determination and denying Israel the right
48 to exist.

50 However, criticism of Israel that is similar to criticism toward
51 any other country may not be regarded as anti-Semitic.

52 (c) Nothing in this subsection shall be construed to
53 diminish or infringe upon any right protected under the First
54 Amendment to the United States Constitution, or the State
55 Constitution. Nothing in this subsection shall be construed to
56 conflict with federal or state discrimination laws.
