7 Section 2. Beginning September 1, 2020, in order to
8 implement the changes made by this act to s. 320.055, Florida
9 Statutes, the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles
10 shall develop methodology to prorate motor vehicle registration
11 renewal fees. The methodology shall give customers the option to
12 renew their registration on their date of birth in 2021 or 2022.
13 Customers whose date of birth is from January to June may choose
14 to renew for 1 to 18 months. Customers whose date of birth is
15 from July to December may choose to renew for 7 to 24 months.
16 Proration is limited to the renewal of an unexpired registration
