Section 553.865, Florida Statutes, is created 11 12 to read: 553.865 Baby-changing table requirements; incorporation 13 14 into the Florida Building Code.-As used in this section, the term: 15 (1) "Baby-changing table" means a table or other device 16 (a) that is installed in a separate, designated location for the 17 purpose of changing an infant's or child's diaper or clothing. 18 19 "Building" means any of the following: (b) 20 1. A theater. 21 2. A sports arena or stadium. 22 3. A convention center, auditorium, or exhibition hall. 23 4. A public library. 24 5. A passenger terminal. 25 An amusement park in a permanent location. 6.

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26 7. A restaurant with a seating capacity of at least 50 27 persons, except when there is a baby-changing table within 300 28 feet of the restaurant's entrance. 29 8. A shopping center or shopping mall larger than 25,000 30 square feet. 31 9. A retail store larger than 5,000 square feet. (2) Pursuant to s. 553.73(1), the commission shall adopt 32 33 by rule a requirement that, except as provided in paragraph 34 (3) (d), a baby-changing table be available in any building that 35 is newly constructed or undergoes substantial renovation on or 36 after October 1, 2019, and that has a restroom open to the public. As used in this subsection, the term "substantial 37 renovation" means any reconstruction, rehabilitation, addition, 38 39 or other improvement that involves more than 50 percent of the 40 gross floor area occupied by the building, and that includes 41 structural changes to any existing public restroom. 42 The rules adopted by the commission pursuant to this (3) 43 section must require or provide at least all of the following: 44 (a) On each floor that contains a restroom, the building 45 must have at least one baby-changing table accessible to women 46 and at least one baby-changing table accessible to men, or at 47 least one baby-changing table accessible to both women and men. (b) 48 The building must have signage indicating the location 49 of each baby-changing table. 50 For any building that has a central directory and (C)

52	mall, the directory must indicate the location of all baby-				
53	changing tables on the premises.				
54	(d) An exemption for buildings when the cost of				
55	installation of the required baby-changing table would exceed 10				
56	percent of the total construction or renovation costs.				
57	Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2019.				

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
