16 (2) A health insurer may not limit a provider's ability to
17 disclose whether a patient's cost-sharing obligation exceeds the
18 cash price for a covered service in the absence of health
19 insurance coverage or the availability of a more affordable
20 service.

21 (3) A health insurer may not require an insured to make a
22 payment for a covered service in an amount that exceeds the cash
23 price of the service in the absence of health insurance
24 coverage.

25 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2019.
